Welcome to Laurimar Pony Club!

We are a small club, dedicated to providing our members with Quality Instruction, giving them the skills needed to enjoy their equine companions. Our curriculum covers riding on the flat, jumping, games and when students are capable, cross country riding. We instruct our members in horsemanship via the PCAV's certificate system which involves hands on theory and workbooks that include easily understood activities. We hope that during their time at our club, our members will develop friendships with like-minded children, which continue over the course of their years at Pony Club.

We encourage our members to participate in local equestrian events and enjoy attending the Whittlesea show each year as a club. Being part of PCAV's Central Zone, our club also competes at the Annual Lowden Family Shield, where all children can participate in a wide range of Pony Club events.

We conduct a minimum of 11 instructional rallies per year, with our allocated weekends being the second and fourth weekend of the month. Weather dependant, we also hold training rallies each month. We run an Inter-club event in January, a Combined Training Day in June and an Open Show in August.

Being a small club, we ask all families to be involved with our committee and help out at our fundraisers which enable us to keep our fees low, whilst still maintaining top quality instructors.

Fees are due upon joining. Instalment plans are available upon request.

Potential members are able to Come and Try Pony Club for the day at a cost of \$20.00 which covers insurance and instruction fees.

Uniform

Members are required to wear an Approved helmet and riding boots at all times. For rallies, any colour jodphurs may be worn with the club polo and/or jacket. At competitions, jophurs need to be fawn, beige or white. The club polo and jacket may be worn or riders may wear the traditional club jumper with white shirt and pony club tie.
